Unfortunately the report this month shows that for the Kesgrave & District SNT, we have seen the seasonal increase in our crime levels compared to recent months.

Kesgrave and **Great Bealings** are the only parishes to see an increase in crime compared to the same time last year. This crime increase includes Theft from Motor Vehicles and as reported by Sgt Street in the April edition of the monthly magazines, that vehicles being left insecure or valuables left on display sadly contribute to this. This is extremely disappointing having spent

many months trying to educate to prevent just this. This increase in Theft from Motor Vehicles was seen across Rushmere and Martlesham.

Tuddenham, Swilland, Playford, Westerfield and Culpho parishes have had a crime free month.

It is pleasing to see a reduction in crime in **Witnesham**, compared to the same time last year. With Anti Social Behaviour in Weyland Road running as a current priority there has been a great deal of work being carried out with the residents and partner agencies. The residents are pleased with the noticeable reduction in ASB. A recent Street Meet was very successful and included a litter pick as part of the multi agency Suffolk wide campaign "Don't be a Tosser keep Suffolk clean", where 20 bin bags were filled with rubbish.
