4. Applications received: Declarations of interest were declared by Mr.Lightfoot re:CO9/1203 and Mr.Rush re: CO9/1203 and 1143.(Personal friends)

CO9/1098 Meadowsweet, Wash Lane, Witnesham
Erection of side extension and porch and alterations to driveway and existing roof including replacement of hips with gable ends (demolition of flat roof side extension).
